



ABCTS/STS PIPELINE PROGRAM CALL FOR APPLICATIONS AND NOMINATIONS!!



The Association of Black Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgeons and the Society of Thoracic Surgeons are announcing our *Pipeline to CT Surgery Scholarship Program*. This is a visiting rotation for AAMC defined underrepresented in medicine (UIM) minority medical students and general surgery residents with an interest in pursuing Cardiothoracic (CT) Surgery training.

Awardees will spend 4 weeks at an academic institution to build relationships with surgical mentors, enhance exposure to CT Surgery and increase the strength of their applications to CT Surgery training programs for eventual match.

Participating Institutions: Brigham & Women's Hospital, Stanford University, UC - Davis,
The Ohio State University, and The University of Maryland

ABCTS/STS Pipeline Program Application requirements:


- 1) CV,
- 2) Essay delineating your interest in CT Surgery (500 words or less), and
- 3) an Endorsement/Letter of Support from their Program Director or Faculty member (highlighting good standing, technical skills, professionalism, etc).
- APPLICATION DEADLINE: January 20, 2025 MLK Day (Applicants are encouraged to apply early)
- Notification of Receipt: by March 1, 2025
- Rotations should be completed during the months of: May September, 2025
- Applicants must meet the local institution's requirements
- Medical students should be in their 3rd or 4th clinical year
- General surgery residents should be in their PGY3 or later at the time of anticipated travel
- Prioritization will be made for applicants from Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and UIM applicants at institutions without a CT Surgery training program
- Up to \$5000 stipend for the travel to cover travel, accommodations, etc...

Join us on X for Thoracic Thursdays!

A patient that was femorally cannulated for VA ECMO develops upper body hypertension and lower body hypotension with evidence of poor oxygenation in the upper body. What is the most likely diagnosis?

- A) North-South Syndrome
- B) Pulmonary embolism
- C) Cardiac tamponade
- D) Aortic dissection

The correct answer is A! North-South Syndrome occurs when the heart begins to recover and competes with the ECMO circuit. Oxygenated blood is delivered to the lower body by the ECMO circuit, while poorly oxygenated blood from the heart flows to the upper body.
